## Unit 6

*Grammar Topics:*

- Comparatives and Superlatives with LONG adjectives
  - REMEMBER: MORE/MOST
    - *It is more expensive.*
    - *It is the most expensive.*
- Irregulars
  - REMEMBER: Sometimes we have irregular forms.
    - *good, better, the best*
    - *bad, worse, the worst*

*Oral Topic:*

- Pick a topic and use as many comparatives as you can to talk about it.

*Useful Vocabulary:*

Break, repair, comfortable, hard, soft, expensive, cheap, wooden, metal, modern

## Unit 7

*Grammar Topics:*

- Future with "Will"
  - REMEMBER: infinitive
  - *I will go to school today.*
- Future with "Will" Negative
  - REMEMBER: Won't
  - *I won't eat these. I don't like them.*

*Oral Topic:*

- Tell me what will happen in a year's time. In two year's time.

*Useful Vocabulary:*

The future, travel, satellite, the moon, the sun, planets, rocket, astronaut, cosmonaut, star, spaceship.

## **Unit 8**

*Grammar Topics:*

- Many/much
  - **REMEMBER:** Countable = many, uncountable = much
    - *How many coins?*
    - *How much milk did you drink?*
- Some/Any
  - **REMEMBER:** Countable OR uncountable.
    - *I didn't do any homework.*
    - *We have some milk.*

*Oral Topic: Role play, supermarket shopping.*

*Useful Vocabulary:*

Money, passengers, arrivals, departures, luggage, passport, suitcase, magazine, newspaper, coin.

## **Unit 9**

*Grammar Topics:*

- Infinitive of Purpose
  - **REMEMBER:** In order to...
    - *I'm going home TO eat.*
- How often?
  - \_\_\_ Times a week
  - twice a month
  - never

*Oral Topic:*

- Tell me about your weekly routine and how often you do things?

*Useful Vocabulary:*

Cartoon, radio, camcorder, the news, documentary, channel, advert, mobile phone.

## **Unit 10**

*Grammar Topics:*

- “Present Perfect Affirmative”
  - **REMEMBER:** Have/Has + PARTICIPLE
    - *I have saved the document*
    - *I've saved the document*
- “Present Perfect Negative”
  - **REMEMBER:** Haven't /Hasn't + PARTICIPLE
    - *I haven't saved the document*
    - *He hasn't saved the document*

*Oral Topic:*

- Tell me what you have learned this year.

*Useful Vocabulary:*

Printer, screen, mouse, log on, log off, speakers, click on, save a document, memory stick, surf the internet.

## **Unit 11**

*Grammar Topics:*

- Present Perfect + Ever
  - **REMEMBER:** Use to ask if you have ever done something in your life
    - *Have you ever been in space?*
    - *Has he ever eaten cucumbers?*
- Present Perfect + Never
  - **REMEMBER:** Show what you never have done.
    - *I have never seen a shark.*

*Oral Topic: Ask me questions about what I have done. Tell me what you have never done.*

*Useful Vocabulary:*

*town, ocean, volcano, village, oasis, rainforest, capital city, dessert, island, cave*

## **Unit 12**

*Grammar Topics:*

- Should/Shouldn't
  - **REMEMBER:** Suggestions
  - *You should eat healthy food*
  - *You shouldn't go to bed so late*
  
- Could/Couldn't
  - **REMEMBER:** Past tense!
  - *I could run quickly when I was a child.*
  - *I couldn't eat milk when I was five.*

*Oral Topic: Tell me what I should and shouldn't do to be healthy.*

*Useful Vocabulary:*

*A headache, feel sick, feel dizzy, a cold, a cough, an earache, a stomach ache, a sore throat.*
